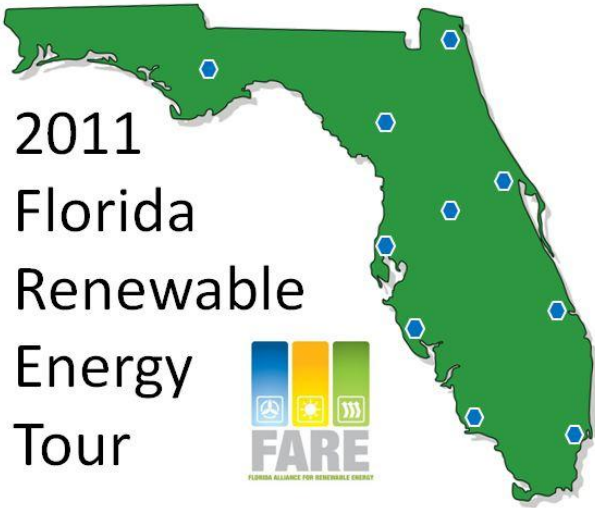


2011 Florida Renewable Energy Tour
