We are seeking a wide range of topics related to learning centers in higher education. This is an opportunity for learning center professionals, faculty, and students from all Florida institutions of higher education to present best practices and research related to enhancement of student learning. Possible topics of interest may include:

- Tutor selection, training, assessment/evaluation
- Effective tutoring techniques
- Setting up an effective learning center / best practices
- Budgeting and supervision in learning centers
- Online academic support
- Learning centers bridging the gap between Academic and Student Affairs
- Support of students at all levels - from developmental education to honors
- Motivation and self-regulation
- Learning strategies and how to incorporate them into academic support
- Academic success courses

The deadline to submit a proposal is 5:00 PM Friday, January 17, 2014. Notification of proposal acceptances will be sent by February 3rd. All conference participants, including those presenting, must pay the conference registration fee (\$100 professional / \$50 student)

All sessions will be 50 minutes long. Proposals must include the following:

- Name, Title, Institution, Email and Phone number for each person presenting
- Presentation Title
- Presentation summary (no more than 50 words)
- Session Outline and Method(s) of Presentation
- Significance to the field and relevance to participants (learning outcomes)
- Target Audience
- Audiovisual Needs
