Dr. Lall's research covers 3 major initiatives that are developed through the Columbia Water Center. The *Global Water Sustainability Initiative* is focused on an assessment of global water scarcity and risk. The *Global Flood Initiative* is motivated by the desire to predict and manage floods at a global scale recognizing their climate drivers, and supply chain impacts. *America's Water* is driven by the goal of developing sustainable water management and infrastructure design paradigms for the 21st century recognizing the linkages between urban functioning, food, water, energy and climate.
