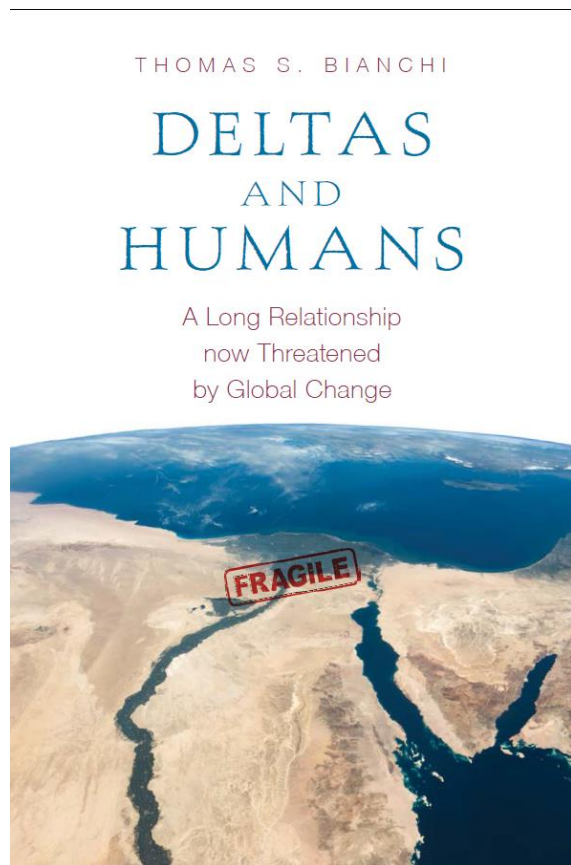


Deltas and Humans

Humans have had a long relationship with the ebb and flow of tides on river deltas around the world. However, this relationship has at times been both nurturing and tumultuous for the development of early civilizations.
